We refer to your email dated 8<sup>th</sup> May 2025 in which you requested information regarding PPS expenditure. Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

### Freedom of Information Act 2000

The Freedom of Information Act creates rights of access for any person making a request for information to a public authority. The rights of access are twofold. First, to be informed by the public authority if it holds information of the description specified in the request, and if that is the case, secondly, to be provided with that information. These rights are subject to important limitations, which are designed to achieve a proper balance between the right to know and considerations of law and policy in the broader public interest.

You had asked the following:

*“I'd like to make a request under the Freedom of Information Act for all of your entity's expenditure over £25,000 for January 2020 to April 2025.*

*Please provide the data in a machine-readable format (preferably CSV). As a minimum, please make sure to include the date, value, and recipient of each transaction. Please also provide details on the procurement category of each transaction if you have it”.*

In response, please see **Tables 1-7** within the separate Excel file which provides PPS expenditure over £25,000 for the period 1 January 2020 to 30 April 2025.

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review in accordance with our review procedure. You should do this as soon as possible or in any case within two months of the date of this response and you can do so by writing to the Head of Policy and Information, Public Prosecution

Service, Belfast Chambers, 93 Chichester Street, BELFAST, BT1 3JR or alternatively by sending an e-mail to [info@ppsni.gov.uk](mailto:info@ppsni.gov.uk). You should state the grounds on which you are requesting the review.
