I refer to your email dated 4 September 2020 in which you asked for information relating to prosecution statistics for domestic abuse.

Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Freedom of Information Act 2000

The Freedom of Information Act creates rights of access for any person making a request for information to a public authority. The rights of access are twofold. Firstly, to be informed by the public authority if it holds information of the description specified in the request, and if that is the case, secondly, to be provided with that information. These rights are subject to important limitations, which are designed to achieve a proper balance between the right to know and considerations of law and policy in the broader public interest.

You had asked for the following:

- 1. The number of defendants reported to the PPS in the last five years in relation to a domestic violence offence (plus gender breakdown).
- 2. Number of defendants prosecuted in connection with a domestic violence offence (including gender breakdown).
- 3. How many domestic violence convictions there have been in the last five years (including gender breakdown).
- 4. What percentage of victims were men in the same categories.
- 5. In the event of not giving a gender breakdown, an explanation as to why it cannot be provided.

In response to questions 1-3, please see Tables 1 to 11 below which provide the information requested for the financial years 2015/16 to 2019/20. These tables include details of files / suspects received on files, PPS prosecutorial decisions issued by type and convictions in both the Crown and Magistrates' Courts. An analysis of suspect / defendant gender has also been provided where appropriate.

Please note the following:

- Tables should be read in conjunction with the explanatory notes provided as these set out any definitions / limitations which may apply to the data.
- Tables 1 and 2 are based on an assessment of domestic violence motivation as provided by police on submission of a file to PPS. Subsequent tables are based on the prosecutor's assessment (i.e. where the prosecutor considered that an offence was motivated by domestic violence).

In respect of questions 4 and 5, please be advised that the PPS does not hold the information requested. Files received from police may relate to multiple suspects, offences and victims; in such cases it is not possible to link individual victims to specific suspects, nor can victims be linked to specific offences. As a result PPS cannot report on the number of victims which relate specifically to suspects or offences flagged as being motivated by domestic violence. Therefore in terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 I can confirm that under Section 1(1)(a) of the Act we do not hold the requested information.

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review in accordance with our review procedure. You should do this as soon as possible or in any case within two months of the date of this response and you can do so by writing to the Head of Policy and Information, Public Prosecution Service, Belfast Chambers, 93 Chichester Street, BELFAST, BT1 3JR or alternatively by sending an e-mail to info@ppsni.gov.uk. You should state clearly the grounds on which you are requesting the review.
