I refer to your email dated 23 February 2022 in which you asked for information relating to prosecutions of indecent exposure and voyeurism. Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Freedom of Information Act 2000

The Freedom of Information Act creates rights of access for any person making a request for information to a public authority. The rights of access are twofold. First, to be informed by the public authority if it holds information of the description specified in the request, and if that is the case, secondly, to be provided with that information. These rights are subject to important limitations, which are designed to achieve a proper balance between the right to know and considerations of law and policy in the broader public interest.

You had asked the following:

"Under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act please providing a response to the following for each of the last 5 years for which figures are available:

The number of prosecutions for incidents of indecent exposure and also for voyeurism".

In response, please see tables below at **Annex A** which outlines the number of prosecutions of indecent exposure between 01/01/17 and 31/12/21, and **Annex B** which details the number of prosecutions of voyeurism between 01/01/17 and 31/12/21.

These tables should be read in conjunction with the accompanying notes.

If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review in accordance with our review procedure. You should do this as soon as possible or in any case within two months of the date of this

response and you can do so by writing to the Head of Policy and Information, Public Prosecution Service, Belfast Chambers, 93 Chichester Street, BELFAST, BT1 3JR or alternatively by sending an e-mail to info@ppsni.gov.uk. You should state clearly the grounds on which you are requesting the review.
