



PPS Register of Interests

Introduction

The purpose of this register is to provide information to the public about relevant interests of the members of the PPS Management Board (MB), Audit and Risk Committee (ARC) and the wider management team. These may be personal or business interests that may influence their judgment, deliberation or action as members of a PPS board / committee, or which might be perceived by a reasonable person as so doing. The register consists of individual responses to a total of eight questions, as follows:

2. Please give details of any relevant employment (other than held with the PPS); that is any remunerated employment, offices held, professions etc. that might affect the carrying out of your duties or responsibilities. Please include the name (and nature) of the organisation and the position(s) held.
3. Please give details of any voluntary offices held.
4. Please give details of any public offices held.
5. Please give details of any sponsorship or financial or material support that you receive from any person or organisation.
6. Please give details of any significant political activity that you are involved in, for example holding office in a political party or standing as a nominated candidate for a political party or making significant contributions to a political party whether monetary or otherwise.
7. Please give details of any relevant interests including significant interests of close family members, i.e. ones which might influence your judgement, deliberation or action as a member of a PPS Board / Committee, or which might be perceived by a reasonable person as so doing.
8. Are there any other matters which you wish to disclose?
